

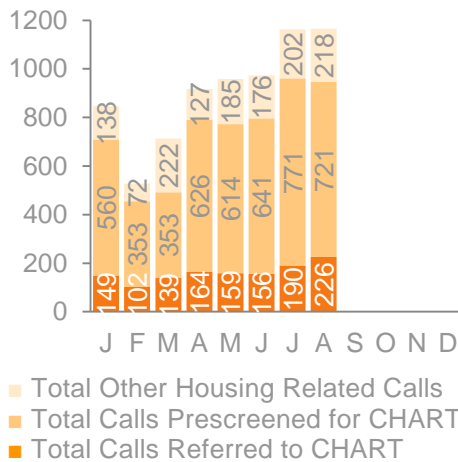
PENNSYLVANIA 2-1-1 EAST

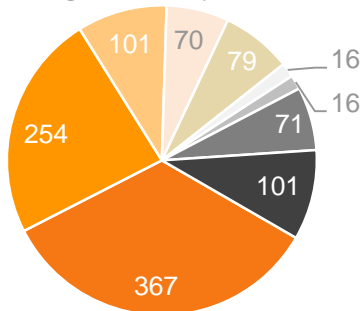
2014 CALL VOLUME

PRESENTING NEEDS

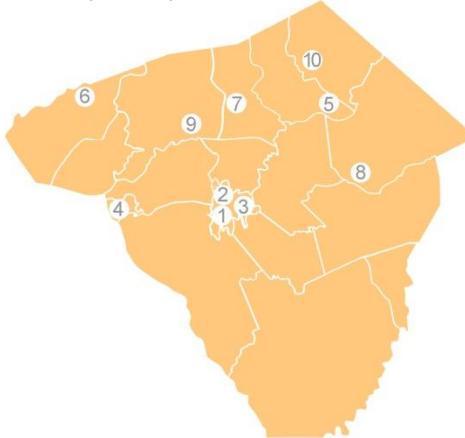
Some callers have multiple housing concerns. Captured are the total housing needs requested.

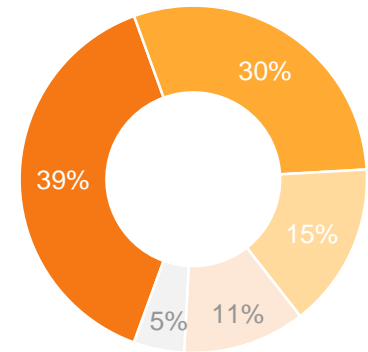
