

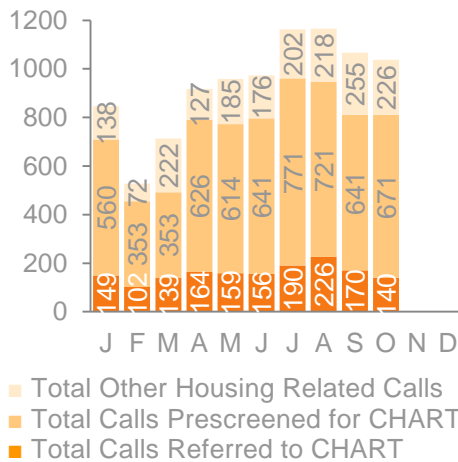
PENNSYLVANIA 2-1-1 EAST

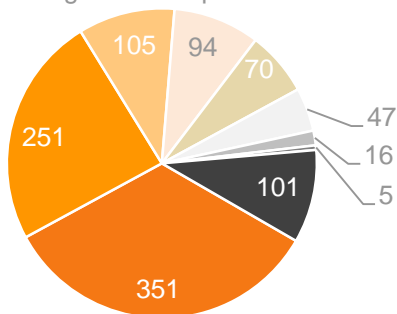
2014 CALL VOLUME

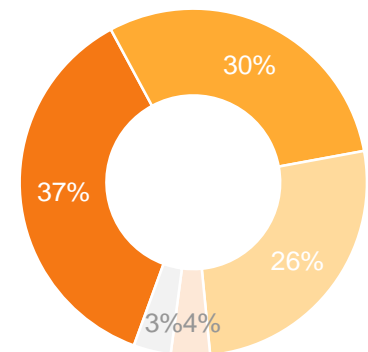
