Community Education Classes

IU13 Community Education offers classes and tutoring services which help to prepare adults and youth for both the workplace and postsecondary education. Many classes are available to Lancaster and Lebanon county learners at no cost. They are located at various sites throughout the community and in county prisons.

Citizenship

These classes help legal permanent residents gain knowledge and English skills needed to pass the citizenship test.

ESL (English as a Second Language)

Immigrants, refugees, and other newcomers can improve their communication skills in order to reach educational, employment, and civic-related goals.

Family Literacy

Recognizing the strong connection between parents' and children's academic success, this program provides high school equivalency instruction for parents and incorporates interactive parent-child literacy activities.

Adult Basic Education (ABE) & High School Equivalency (HSE)

These classes focus on reading, writing, math, science, and social studies skills in preparation for the GED and HiSET tests, employment opportunities, and postsecondary school.

Distance Education

Adult students can enroll in ABE, HSE (High School Equivalency), ESL, and other courses in an online format using the Internet, workbooks, and videos in a structured program outside the classroom.



Health Careers and Workplace Skills

Students interested in obtaining employment in high priority occupations such as healthcare, manufacturing, office and administrative support, and construction can take classes to prepare them to enter certification and postsecondary programs. Community Education offers specialized classes for students preparing for the Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) entrance exam, the WorkKeys® assessment, and more.
